- Discuss how to identify those most critical Essential Functions (EFs) that must continue through an emergency and the planning required to perform those functions
- Review the Essential Elements of a viable continuity capability and how they correspond to your organization's planning
- Identify solutions or alternative actions to challenges, gaps or vulnerabilities in your organization's continuity plans and procedures
