COURSE CONTENT: This exercise is designed to increase participant knowledge of requirements for Continuity of Operations readiness and response for a **Regional Cyber Attack**.

Upon Completion of this exercise (TTX) participants should be able to: INCREASE THE AWARENESS OF FEDERAL, STATE, TERRITORIAL, TRIBAL AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT JURISDICTIONS OF THE IMPORTANCE OF INCLUDING CYBER SECURITY CONSIDERATIONS INTO CONTINUITY PLANNING; DISCUSS HOW TO IDENTIFY THOSE MOST CRITICAL ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS (EF's) THAT MUST CONTINUE THROUGH AN EMERGENCY AND THE PLANNING REQUIRED TO PERFORM THOSE FUNCTIONS; REVIEW THE ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF A VIABLE CONTINUITY CAPABILITY AND HOW THEY CORRESPOND TO AN ORGANIZATION'S PLANNING; and IDENTIFY SOLUTIONS OR ALTERNATIVE ACTIONS TO CHALLENGES, GAPS OR VULNERABILITIES IN AN ORGANIZATION'S CONTINUITY PLANS AND PROCEDURES. **Participation is VERY limited.**
